films or similar records, and then only for public exhibition by some charitable, educational, religious or patriotic organization, upon an occasion and at a time, and under such restrictions, as said Clerk may deem right and proper; provided that the Circuit Court for Carroll County may in all cases authorize the temporary removal of any such record, book, paper or proceedings deposited for safe keeping with its Clerk.
