### AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY OF CECIL COUNTY.

P. L. L., 1888, Art. 8, sec. 1. 1888, ch. 138.

1. For the purpose of preserving order, enforcing the rules and regulations of the agricultural society of Cecil County, not inconsistent with the laws of this State, and for the protection of property, the several justices of the peace in Cecil County are authorized and empowered, upon the request of the president, vice-president, or any of the managers of said society, to summon and detail, in the name of the State of Maryland, such constabulary force as the president, vice-president or managers of said society may deem sufficient for the perfect preservation of peace and order, the protection of property, and the full enforcement of the rules and
