**659.** The bonds herein provided for shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum, and shall be signed by the Mayor and Clerk of said corporation and sealed with the corporate seal, and shall be denominated Westernport General Improvement Bonds, that the said bonds shall be issued in denominations of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), payable thirty years from the date of issuing and redeemable at the option of the said Town of Westernport at any time after five years from the date of issuing. That said bonds shall be exempt from all taxation for Allegany County, municipal tax, Westernport and school purposes.

**660.** The said the Mayor and Commissioners of Westernport in the event of the approval of such ordinance or ordinances, either as to one or more of the said items for improvements by the qualified voters of the said Town of Westernport as herein provided for, are hereby authorized and empowered to do all things necessary for the issuance of such bonds, their offering for sale under the most advantageous terms and conditions, the providing of a sinking fund for the purposes of meeting the interest on said bonds, and their payment upon maturity, and all other things in connection with the procuring of the loan and the issuance and payment of the bonds and carrying on the work provided under the ordinance or ordinances as may be necessary and proper.

**661.** The Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Westernport in Allegany County shall have full power and authority to contract with any corporate body, individuals or other persons in order to establish a complete system of water works for the Town of Westernport, and shall have power to regulate the erection and management of the same, by passing ordinances pertaining thereto, and also to grant by ordinances or otherwise the right to lay conduits or water mains through the streets of said town, or may contract for such service themselves. And authority is hereby given said Mayor and Commissioners of Westernport to condemn any land, earth or stone or any interest therein, either in Allegany or Garrett Counties, if they are not able to agree with the owners for such rights of way, if the same should become necessary for the erection of the aforesaid water system; and the Mayor and Commissioners of Westernport in Allegany County shall have all the right and authority as set out in Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland from Sections 329 to 336, inclusive, and to contract for and condemn land of sufficient width for the placing of conduits or water pipes and land for reservoirs for the use of said water system, and they shall have power to pass all such ordinances as may be necessary into effect this provision.
