**505.** No person shall cast, throw or fire any squib, rocket, cracker or other combustible fireworks within half a mile of the Methodist Protestant Church in the village of Liberty, in Frederick county, and any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this section shall, on conviction before any justice of the peace in said county, be fined not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars and shall pay the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall be committed to jail and confined therein until said fine and costs are paid.

**506.** All fines and penalties imposed and collected for violations of the provisions of the two preceding sections shall be paid to the board of county school commissioners of said county for the use of the public schools of said county.

**507.** It shall not be lawful for any person or persons to be found drunk or acting in a riotous or disorderly manner to the disturbance of the peace of any citizen or citizens within the village of Liberty, or within one mile of the Methodist Protestant Church, in said village in Frederick county, Maryland, and any person or persons who shall be convicted thereof before any justice of the peace of said district, shall be fined not less than one dollar nor more than five dollars, and the cost of prosecution, and in default of the payment of said fine and costs shall be committed to the jail of said county and confined therein for a period of not less than ten days, nor more than twenty days, provided, that any person or persons so convicted shall have the right of appeal to the Circuit Court for said county upon giving bond in a sum to be fixed by said justice, sufficient to secure the payment of said fine and costs, and the probable costs in said court, conditioned that if the party appealing shall not prosecute his appeal with effect at the next term of the Circuit Court for Frederick county, and also pay and satisfy said fine and costs and the costs in said court in case the judgment shall be affirmed, then the said bond to be and remain in full force and virtue, otherwise to be of no effect.
