The Burgess and Council of Myersville is hereby authorized and empowered to construct, establish and maintain a water supply system in and for the town of Myersville, in Frederick County, Maryland, for the purpose of furnishing an adequate and proper supply of water in said town for all private and municipal purposes.

632. All fish dams or other devices for catching fish, and all other erections in the Monocacy River below Kemp's lately Davis' mill dam, are nuisances, and may be pulled down and abated as such by any person, and the person erecting the same shall be liable to indictment, as in other cases of nuisances.

633. If any person shall obstruct or hinder any other person from abating such nuisance, or shall assault or wound any person for abating the same, after attempting so to do, he shall, besides being subject to an action by the party injured, forfeit the sum of one hundred dollars, to be recovered by action of debt in the circuit court for said county, or by indictment in said court, one-half to the informer or to him who will sue for or prosecute the same with effect, and the other half to the use of the county.
