the State, and if the appeal should be decided against the State, the costs of the appeal shall be paid by the county commissioners of said county, otherwise to be awarded against the railroad company.

It shall not be lawful for any huckster, dealer or merchant to receive or purchase from anyone in the corporation of Frederick City between sunset and sunrise of the following morning, any turkeys, geese, ducks, chickens or guinea fowls, either dead or live, and anyone violating any of the provisions of this law shall, on conviction in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, be fined not less than twenty-five dollars, or, in the discretion of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, be committed and confined in the Maryland House of Correction for not less than two months, and not more than one year.
