

The said authorities may classify property under this Act as soon as it meets the requirements thereof, but the special tax shall not attach until the year following such classification. As soon as said classification by the local authorities so charged with the duty of classifying under this sub-title, shall have been made, they shall certify to the collector of taxes of Howard County the amount due against each property falling within any of the classes hereinabove mentioned, together with a description of the property, and the name of the owner or owners thereof, and it shall thereupon be the duty of the collector to collect such special tax and pay the same into the County Treasury to reimburse the County for the money already appropriated and which shall hereafter be appropriated. The said Collector of Taxes shall add said special tax to the tax bill of the property as a separate item to be called "Special Road Tax."

275. The use of the public roads and highways located within Howard County, other than highways under the control of the State Roads Commission, by vehicles having a gross weight including the weight of the vehicle and load, of more than 10,000 pounds, is hereby prohibited unless such roads or highways be frozen at the time of such use, between January 1st and April 15th in each year, and at such other times as the County Commissioners, Road Engineer or other agency of Howard County having supervision and control of the highways of such County may deem necessary, provided, at such times other than between January 1st and April 15th of each year notices shall be posted along such highway of the limitations of its use.

276. The provisions of Section 275 shall not apply to vehicles run upon rails or tracks or to police vehicles, fire engines or fire trucks.

277. Any one violating the provisions of this Act shall, upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace, or other tribunal having criminal jurisdiction, pay a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars nor more than Two Hundred Dollars for each and every offense, together with costs of prosecution, and the vehicle operated by such person shall be held as security for the payment of such fine and costs and such person shall stand committed to the County Jail until such fine and costs are paid.

Whenever a majority of the registered voters of any district of Howard County files a written application or petition with the County Commissioners of Howard County requesting them to issue bonds, the proceeds arising from the sale of such bonds to be applied to the building or repairing of county roads, bridges and culverts in that district. The said County Commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to issue
