

found guilty of so selling or manufacturing such malt or liquor within said corporate limits shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars, or shall be subject to not more than three months' imprisonment in the Maryland House of Correction, or both, in the discretion of the Court.

780. Until the first election to be held under the provisions of this Act, and until their successors have been duly elected and qualified, the Mayor and Councilmen holding office at the date of the going into effect of this act, shall hold their respective offices unless they, or any of them, shall become otherwise disqualified under the provisions hereof; and the Town Clerk holding office at the date of the going into effect of this act shall act as Town Clerk and Treasurer until his successor has been duly appointed and qualified unless he shall become otherwise disqualified hereunder; and all of said officers shall hold their respective places and perform their duties and be subject to all liabilities in the same manner, and to the same extent as if they had been duly elected under the provisions of this act.

SIDEWALKS.

781. The Mayor and Common Council of Mt. Rainier, Maryland, a municipal corporation are hereby authorized to construct sidewalks in the said town of Mt. Rainier, Maryland, when, where and in the manner to be determined by the said Mayor and Common Council, and to establish sidewalk grades after a general plan for the benefit of the whole town.

782. To effectuate the construction of sidewalks mentioned in the preceding section, the Mayor and Common Council of Mount Rainier, Maryland, are hereby authorized and empowered to borrow from time to time, on the credit of the town a sum or sums of money which shall not, however, exceed at any one time the total sum of twenty thousand (\$20,000) dollars in amount; and to issue certificates of indebtedness therefor, which shall be payable within three years from the date of issuance, with interest not to exceed the rate of six per centum (6%) per annum, payable semi-annually, unless of shorter duration, then at the maturity of said obligation. The funds derived from the sale of said certificates of indebtedness shall be deposited by the Mayor and Common Council of Mount Rainier, Maryland, in some safe banking institution in the State of Maryland, to be determined by them and to be subject to the check of the town Clerk and Treasurer only when countersigned by the Mayor and two members of the Common Council. Out of said funds shall be paid only the proper expenses for the negotiation and sale of said certificates of indebtedness and for the planning and construction of the sidewalks, as provided for herein.
