to the action of debt or such other civil remedies as may exist in such cases by law for the recovery of the penalties thereunto affixed, they may affix thereto such reasonable fines, not exceeding fifty dollars in any case, as to them may appear right, and in default of the payment of any fine imposed, they may provide for the imprisonment of the offenders for a period not exceeding thirty days, or until the fines are paid; provided, that no ordinance shall be adopted except by a yea and nay vote, and the names of the members of the Council voting for and against the same shall be entered in the minutes.

- (C) The Council is hereby authorized to pay over to the Board of County School Commissioners of Montgomery and, or, Prince George's County, such sums as may in the discretion of the Council be necessary or advisable, for expenditure within the corporate limits of the town, for the purpose of aiding in the acquisition of land for school and playground sites; aiding in the construction, operation, and maintenance of public school buildings; assisting in the payment of salaries of public school teachers, and generally to aid in promoting the efficiency of the public schools located within the limits of the town. Such sums may, for the purposes named in this subsection, be appropriated from the funds in the treasury of the town not otherwise appropriated or allotted at the date of the enactment of this Charter; or such sums may be paid from the general revenue of the town; or such sums may be raised by creating indebtedness for the purpose as provided in Subsection 961-I* of this Charter.
- (D) Whenever any work of any nature is to be performed the estimated cost of which exceeds one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), which estimate shall be entered on the minutes of the Council, notice of two weeks shall be given by posting in some conspicuous places in the town, and publication at least twice during that period, in some newspaper of general circulation in the town, that bids will be received for said work. When the estimated cost of such work does not exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), the contract therefor may be let or the work performed by the said Council without previous posting and publication of notice. The Council may reject any or all bids and advertise anew. When a contract is awarded for work the estimated cost of which exceeds five hundred dollars (\$500.00) it shall be by ordinance duly passed.
- (E) It shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to provide a place for betting or gaming purposes or to bet, wager, or gamble in any manner or by any means, or to make or sell pools within the corporate limits of the town of Takoma Park, Maryland, on the result of any race of any kind.
- (F) The said Council shall have power by ordinance to provide for the puishment of any person, persons or corporations who shall violate any of the provisions of this section by a fine not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) in any one case, or imprisument in the county jail of the county
