All ordinances and by-laws heretofore passed by "The Commissioners of the Village of Leonardtown," and now in force and not in conflict with the provisions of this charter, shall be valid and remain in force until the same are repealed, amended or modified by "The Commissioners of Leonardtown"; and all Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, heretofore passed, relating to or in any way affecting "The Commissioners of the Village of Leonardtown," and not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, shall remain in force and effect for "The Commissioners of Leonardtown" in the same manner and to the same extent and purpose as if said Act or Acts were now repealed and re-enacted so as to read in lieu of the words "The Commissioners of the Village of Leonardtown," the words, "The Commissioners of Leonardtown."

A majority of "The Commissioners of Leonardtown" shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and in the absence of the president of their Board, the Commissioners present may appoint a member president pro tem., who shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the rules and regulations prescribed for the president.
