The Chairman of the State Roads Commission and Director of Public Works shall, on or before the second Tuesday in December, in each and every year, beginning on the second Tuesday in December in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-four, appoint some competent person, who shall have sufficient knowledge and experience, in the estimation and judgment of the Chairman of the State Roads Commission and Director of Public Works to enable him to discharge properly the duties of grading, draining, maintaining, repairing and reconstructing the public roads and bridges of said County, County Road Superintendent for Somerset County, at a salary not to exceed one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) a year, payable monthly; and the said county road superintendent shall hold his office and be paid for his services from the first day of January next succeeding his appointment for one year, unless sooner removed, as hereinafter provided.
