This Article shall be cited as the "State Police Act."

- The following words and phrases as used in this Article shall have or include the following meanings:
- (a) "Department" shall mean the "Department of Maryland State Police" as created by this Article.

 (b) "Employee" shall mean any employee of the Department.
- (c) "Police Employees" shall mean any employee who is assigned to police work as a peace officer, pursuant to Section 19 of this Article.
- (d) "Civilian Employee" shall mean any employee assigned to a position other than that of police employee.
