2. The members of said Commission shall receive no compensation but such necessary expenses as may be incurred in the performance of their duties, shall be paid by the Comptroller of the Treasury on the presentation of an itemized account with proper vouchers, provided that such expenses shall in no case exceed the amounts appropriated therefor.

Appropriations shall from time to time be made for surveys, traveling expenses, office rent, stationery, postage, printing, advertising, telegraph, telephone, mimeographing, multigraphing, books, periodicals, office furniture and the like, and to provide prizes and programs for community fairs and farmers conferences, and for other similar general or educational purposes.

3. Said Commission shall make such By-Laws and regulations, not inconsistent with this Article, as it may deem proper. It shall have full and plenary powers to investigate interracial conditions and to promote the welfare of the colored race and the betterment of interracial relations.

The Executive Secretary shall record the transactions of the Commission and perform such other duties as may be ordered by the Commission.
