

- 66. Counterfeiting physician's prescriptions, recipes, etc.; penalty.
- 67. Counterfeiting tickets, coupons, tokens, etc.; penalty.

Cruelty to Animals.

- 70. Cruelty of any kind to animals a misdemeanor.
