194. Any person who shall wilfully wear the insignia, uniform or button of The American Legion, or the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, or the Disabled American Veterans of the World War or the United Spanish War Veterans, or the official decorations of said organizations, or use the same to obtain aid or assistance within this State, unless he or she shall be entitled to use or wear the same under the constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations of such organizations, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, and in default of payment committed to jail for a period not to exceed thirty days.

195. Any association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or association, historical, military, or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization or association degree, branch, subordinate lodge, or auxiliary thereof, whether incorporated or unincorporated, the principles and activities of which are not repugnant to the Constitution and laws of the United States or of this State, may register, in the office of the Secretary of State, a facsimile, duplicate, or description of its name, badge, motto, button, decoration, charm, emblem, rosette or other insignia, and may, by re-registration alter or cancel the same.

196. Application for such registration, alteration, or cancellation shall be made by the chief officer or officers of said association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or associations, historical, military, or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization, or association, degree, branch, subordinate lodge, or auxiliary thereof, upon blanks to be provided by the Secretary of State; and such registration shall be for the use, benefit, and on behalf of all associations, degrees, branches, subordinate lodges, and auxiliaries of said association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or association, historical, military, or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization, or association, degree, branch, subordinate lodge, or auxiliary thereof, and the individual members and those hereafter to become members thereof, throughout the State.

197. The Secretary of State shall keep a properly indexed record of the registration provided for by this sub-title, which record shall also show any altered or cancelled registration.
