If any person against whom any judgment may be rendered for the penalty provided in section 9 shall not immediately pay the same and the costs of the prosecution or give security satisfactory to the justice rendering the judgment for the payment, he shall be committed to jail; there to remain until the same shall be paid or until the expiration of ten days from the date of the commitment, whichever shall first occur.
