all moneys received by the State from appropriations made by the Congress of the United States for vocational rehabilitation of persons disabled in industry or otherwise, and authorize the State Treasurer to make disbursements therefrom upon the order of the State Board of Education; (3) empower and direct the State Board of Education to co-operate with the Federal Board of Vocational Education in carrying out the provisions of the Federal Civilian Vocational Rehabilitation Act.
