

375. Rates not to be decreased by false billing or otherwise.
376. Interchange of passengers and freight; discriminations between carriers, prohibited.
377. Long and short haul. Distribution of cars; power of commission.
378. General powers and duties of commission with respect to carriers, etc.
379. Reports of public service corporations; information to be furnished commission.
380. Investigation of accidents; notice. General investigation. Complaints.
381. Reasonable rates; safe and adequate service; power of commission.
382. Maximum or minimum rates, power to fix.
383. Mileage, excursion and commutation tickets, regulation of.
384. Commission may require carriers to receipt for milk containers; law applicable upon passage of such requirement.
