CHAPTER 361.

AN ACT to pay to the estate of Mrs. Mary E. A. K. Hammond and to Miss Anna W. Hammond, of Frederick county, State taxes paid in error.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the State be and he is hereby authorized to pay out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of twenty-two dollars and twenty-two cents to Grafton B. Hammond, executor of the last will of Mary E. A. K. Ham- To repay. mond, deceased, of Frederick county; and the further sum of thirty-five dollars and sixty cents to Anna W. Hammond also of Frederick county, being for State taxes paid in error by said Mary E. A. K. Hammond and Anna W. Hammond respectively upon Baltimore city stock, and the comptroller of the treasury is hereby authorized to issue his warrant upon said treasurer for the payment of said amounts the same having been recommended by the officers of the treasury department.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from Effective the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 362.

AN ACT to amend section three, of article twelve, of the constition of this State.

Section 1, Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, Three-fifths of all the members of the two houses concurring, that the following section be and the same is hereby proposed as To amend. an amendment to the constitution of this State, and if adopted by the legal and qualified voters thereof as herein provided, it shall supersede and stand in the place and instead of section three, of article twelve, of said constitution.

2. The board of public works is hereby authorized, subject to such regulations and conditions as the General Assembly may from time to time prescribe, to sell the State's interest in all works Amentof internal improvement, whether as a stockholder or a creditor, and also the State's interest in any banking corporation, receiving in payment the bonds and registered debt now owing by the State, equal in amount to the price obtained for the State's said interest.
