(House Bill 280)

AN ACT concerning

Local Government and Referendum Petitions

FOR the purpose of ~~eliminating~~ altering certain requirements for signers of certain petitions and persons who attest to the authenticity of the signature; ~~giving--the General--Assembly--the--authority--to~~ providing that the General Assembly shall prescribe by law the form of certain petitions, the manner for authentication and other administrative procedures; generally relating to procedures relating to certain petitions; and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.
