## ROADS.

The Act of 1862, ch. 216, adds the following sections to this Article:

- SEC. 1. The county commissioners of Carroll county are authorized in their discretion to re-survey and mark and bound the public roads in said county, when and where they may deem such re-survey necessary and expedient.
- 2. Whenever the said commissioners shall deem it expedient that any of the public roads in said county shall be re-surveyed, they shall appoint three persons, not interested, nor holding lands through which said road may pass, and the persons so appointed, or a majority of them after giving thirty days public notice thereof, shall meet on the premises, and re-survey and mark and bound such public road, according to the best evidence they can obtain of the location thereof, either by examination of witnesses, or by reference to former surveys, or by personal inspection of such road and in the absence of other sufficient and satisfactory evidence, the said persons so appointed as aforesaid are authorized to adopt the centre of such road as the centre thereof according to its true location, and to mark and bound such road accordingly, giving it the proper width to which it
