mayor and five aldermen for said city, at the city-hall in Frederick, until the court house, now in process of erection, shall be completed.

LOANS AND TAXES.

The Act of June 14, 1861, ch. 64, repeals the 16th chapter of the same year, and enacts as follows:

- 15. The county commissioners for Frederick county are hereby authorized and required to build a new court-house in Frederick city for Frederick county, to tear down and remove the buildings now used and occupied as the clerk's office and register's office and to borrow from time to time for that purpose the required sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of forty thousand dollars.
- 16. Said county commissioners are hereby authorized and required to rent and procure in Frederick city suitable and convenient rooms to be used by the Register of Wills for said county as a register's office and Orphan's Court room, and by the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county as a clerk's office, until said new court-house shall be completed and ready for use and occupation by said officers, and the said Register of Wills and the clerk of the Circuit Court are hereby authorized and required to remove from the offices now used by them respectively, the papers and records in their custody, and to deliver to said county commissioners whenever by them thereto required, full possession of the buildings now occupied by said register and clerks.
- 17. Said county commissioners are hereby authorized to appoint one or more watchmen to guard and keep secure by night in the rooms to be procured as aforesaid, the records and papers belonging to said offices and to pay said watchmen such salary as said commissioners shall deem just.
- 18. Said county commissioners are hereby authorized and required to issue bonds in sums of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, to be signed by the president of the board of said county commissioners and coun-
