ALMSHOUSE.

The Act of 1862, ch. 30, repeals sections 2, 3 of this article, and substitutes the following.

SEC. 1. The commissioners of Montgomery county shall, in the second week of November, in every year, appoint five persons, inhabitants of said county, trustees of the poor of said
