D., chief clerk of the said A. B., and on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, made oath as follows, viz: I, C. D., chief clerk of A. B., tobacco inspector, have carefully read the above oath made by him, and swear on the Holy Evangely of Almighty God, that I believe the same to be true in letter and spirit."
