COLLECTORS.

Chapter 326 adds the following Sections:

SEC. 1. The County Commissioners for Prince George's county shall, on or before the first Tuesday of July in each year, appoint a collector or collectors for said county for the collection of taxes levied or to be levied for the current year.

2. The clerk of the County Commissioners for Prince George's county shall annually, on or before the first day of July, inform the Governor whether there is in said county a duly appointed and qualified collector of the State taxes.
