The said commissioners for the performance of the duties prescribed in this act, shall be entitled to charge and receive the sum of twenty-five cents *per capita*, for each and every slave by him recorded as so formerly owned, to be paid in all cases by the former owner or owners, and no compensation or charge of any kind whatever, under the provisions of this act shall be paid out of the state treasury.
