PROVISOR.

SEC. 20. Any person interested may appeal from the decision of the court on any question under this article, *provided*, such appeal be entered within thirty days, and a certified copy of the record be transmitted to the court of appeals within sixty days from the date of the decision appealed from; *and provided also*, that the execution or effect of any judgment, decree, decision or order, so appealed from, shall not be suspended or staid, unless a bond shall be given in such penalty and condition, and with such security, as the court may prescribe and approve.
