It shall be the duty of the permanent board of Permanent examiners to meet on the first Monday in Septem-board of commitment of the permanent of the permane ber, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, and annually annually. thereafter on the first Monday in April, for the pur-Their duties. pose of granting and renewing licenses, the board shall grant licenses only to those candidates who, Licenses. by a careful examination are ascertained to have a proper knowledge of natural philosophy, chemistry, anatomy, physiology, materia medica and therapeutics and the principles and practice of medicine, of surgery, and of obstetrics, and shall renew licenses that may have been obtained from the temporary as well as those obtained from the permenent boards, without subjecting applicants to an examination; provided, however, that nothing herein contained Provisos. shall be construed so as to prevent said board from granting special licenses, after proper examination to such as may desire to practice only one or more of the branches above enumerated; provided, also, that nothing herein contained shall be construed so as to prescribe the mode or manner in which diseases are to be treated, every physician having proven that he has a proper knowledge of the principles of medicine, shall be at liberty to treat diseases according to his individual honest convictions.

7. Each physician shall renew his license at the Ibid. s. 7. annual meeting of the board of examiners, and shall renewed. pay five dollars for the same; provided, however, Proviso. that if he can prove that he has attended the last preceding annual election of examiners, he shall pay only two dollars into the treasury of the board.

- 8. After the election of the aforesaid permanent Ibid. s. s. medical board, no person shall be permitted to practice without license tice medicine, surgery, or obstetrics and receive payment for his services, without having first obtained a license certified as directed by this law, under a penalty of one hundred dollars for each offence.
- 9. No person not authorized by this act to praction allowed to tice medicine, surgery, or obstetrics, shall be perpendent and to make the name of about mitted to practice any of those branches in the name of another.
