experimental school, to be paid in part, from the tuition fees derived from the pupils of said model schools.

111. The annual sum of seven thousand dollars is Ibid, s. 8 Appropriation hereby appropriated for the support of the state for support of normal school, to be paid in quarterly instalments, commencing on the first day of October, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, by the treasurer, on warrant of the comptroller, and to be distributed by the state superintendent as the board of education may direct, but only for teachers' salaries and the purchase of educational apparatus; the cost of text books, stationery, fuel, light and cleaning the rooms, shall be charged to the incidental expenses of the school, and paid on the first day of January and the first day of July, in each year by the treasurer, upon warrant of comptroller, and certificate of state board of education, provided such sum shall not exceed one thousand dollars.

112. All donations or bequests of money or other Ibid s 9 personal property, and all grants or devises of lands such school for the benefit of the state normal school shall be held in trust by the state board of education.

113. The sum of two thousand dollars, or so much 1101d s 10 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for furniture to purchase furniture for the normal school, to be paid by the treasurer on warrant of the comptroller and certificate of state superintendent of public instruction.

114. All male students of the state normal school Ibid s. 11. shall be taught military tactics, embracing the manual to be taught for infantry, the school of the company and battalion, tactics. to qualify them to introduce a proper system of military instruction in the primary schools and high schools of the state.

115. The adjutant-general of the state shall, upon Ibid s. 12. requisition from the state board of education, furnish ral to furnish to the state normal school such arms and equipments arms, &c. as are needed for the use of the students.
