

of their respective counties, the same being in addition to the sum now received by said counties for school purposes, to wit; to Allegany county, Baltimore county, Carroll county, Calvert county, Cecil county, Caroline county, Charles county, St. Mary's county, Harford county, Howard county, Prince George's county, Queen Anne's county, Somerset county, Talbot county, Worcester county and Washington county, each the aforesaid sum of four hundred dollars.

1866, c. 139 enacts the following:

153. The judges of the orphans' courts in the several counties who had charge of the free school fund, are hereby authorised to pay out of any money in their hands belonging to the said fund, to the present registers of wills, or the late registers of wills under the constitution of eighteen hundred and fifty-one, for their services, a reasonable compensation in preserving and keeping the school fund from eighteen hundred and fifty-one to the present time.
