

4. A certified copy of every public general law made to take effect as aforesaid, shall be transmitted by mail, by the secretary of the senate, (if the same originated in the senate,) and by the chief clerk of house of delegates, (if the same originated in the house of delegates,) to such two daily newspapers of the city of Baltimore, and one newspaper in each county, having the largest circulation, (if there be a newspaper published in said county,) as the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of delegates may respectively designate for publication, as provided in the first section of this article.

To what newspapers certified copies of public general laws to be sent.

In force from January 24, 1865.

## ARTICLE —.

### Registration.

1865, c 159 enacts, that there shall be added to the Public General Laws, a new article, bearing the title, Registration, under which shall be arranged by titles and sections, as in other articles of the code, the laws to be made by the general assembly on the subjects of the registry of births, marriages, deaths and voters, as required in article third of the Constitution of 1864, sections forty-one and forty-nine, and such other subjects of Registration as the Legislature may enact and direct.

#### BIRTHS, MARRIAGES AND DEATHS.

- 1 Facts to be recorded by clerks of courts and how record book of births of marriages marriage licenses blank forms to be furnished record book of deaths
- 2 Record books, how paged, indexed, &c.
3. Duties of parents, householders, prison-keepers, clergymen, &c., to give notice to clerks of courts penalty.
4. Duty of physicians.
- 5 Of sextons, coroners, undertakers, &c.
6. Notice may be given to justices duty of the same.
7. Certified copies to be transmitted to secretary of senate.
8. Records of births, &c. evidence.
