## BIRTHS, MARRIAGES AND DEATHS.

# 1865, c. 130 enacts the following:

1865, c 130, s 1. Facts to be recorded by clerks of courts, and how.

SEC. 1. The clerks of the circuit courts of the several counties and the clerk of the court of common pleas of Baltimore city, shall receive and record in books prepared for the purpose, the following facts concerning the births, marriages and deaths in said county or city, separately numbering and recording the same in the order in which he receives them, designating in separate columns:

Record book of

First. In the record book of births, the date of the birth, the place of birth, the name of the child, (if it have any,) the sex and color of the child, the names of the parents, the occupation of the father, the residence of the parents, and the date of the record.

### 1866, c. 102 amends and re-enacts sub-section second as follows:

1866, c 102 Record book of marriages.

Second. In the record book of marriages, the name, residence, age, color, condition (whether single, widow or widower,) and occupation of each of the parties, with the date of record, which said particulars, with the exception of the date of record, shall be ascertained and inserted in the body of the marriage license by the clerk issuing the same, and at the time thereof, and the date, place of marriage, name,
