his county, be fined in each case not less than five or Penalty. more than twenty-five dollars in the discretion of the court; provided, that the road supervisors in those Proviso. counties where the county commissioners make the appropriation and levy for roads in advance of the expenditure by the supervisors shall not be required or authorized to expend in the repair of roads within their respective districts, a larger sum per mile than shall have been levied by the county commissioners for that purpose.

5. How and when clerks or registers required to give counter security penalty for non-compliance fees of office attachable.

How and when ister of wills of any county or the city of Baltimore clerks or registers required to shall, by petition under oath, certify to the judge of give counter security. the circuit court of such county or city that he believes himself to be in danger of suffering from his securityship, from the defalcation of such clerk or register or from other malfeasance in office, the judge of such court shall forthwith pass an order requiring a copy of the said petition to be served on such clerk or register within five days, and shall within ten days thereafter take up the case, and if he shall be satisfied, from the evidence of the truth of the matters alleged, he shall pass an order requiring such clerk or register within a specified time to give counter security, to be approved in the same man-
