18. Potatoes. 20. Corn barrel measure, &c.

1861, c. 78, professes to repeal section 226 of Article II of the Public Local Laws as far as relates to the counties therein named. This is clearly an error, and the evident reference is to section 18 of this Article, which is taken from the act of 1860, c. 226, s. 2, which the author of the law probably had before him, and hence the error. The act of 1861 is therefore inserted here:

1861, c 78. SEC. 18. Section two hundred and twenty-six of Potatoes article two of the public local laws, is hereby repealed so far as its provisions apply to the sale of potatoes in the counties of Frederick, Washington, Allegany, Anne Arundel, Carroll and Montgomery.
