REGISTER OF WILLS.

1865, c. 118 repeals section 146 and re-enacts the same as follows :

146. The register of wills for Baltimore county shall keep a general alphabet or index to the records of the wills, and of such other matters recorded in said office, as the public convenience may require, and shall be entitled to demand and receive from the party from whom the service is performed, ten cents for each will or other matter entered therein ; and it shall be his duty to enter in said general alphabet or index, all such wills or other matters as have not been entered in said index up to the beginning of the term of the present incumbent of said office, and shall be entitled to receive therefor the said sum of ten cents for each entry on said index. The county commissioners for Baltimore county are hereby authorized and directed to levy for and pay over said amount to the register of wills of Baltimore county, upon the certificate of the judges of the orphans' court that said services have been properly performed.
