ity; and provided, also, that the live stock of any kind, actually belonging to the government of the U S stock to United States, or brought in to be weighed for de in weighing. livery to the said government under any then subsisting contract, shall always be entitled to be weighed in preference and priority to all other stock belonging to private parties, or which are presented to be weighed for delivery under private contract.

469. Whenever, in his judgment, it may be neces-May appoint sary for the public accommodation to employ any clerk. clerk or assistant weighmaster, in addition to the clerk and assistant weighmaster, whom he is now authorized to appoint, he may, with the approbation of the comptroller, appoint an additional clerk or additional weighmaster, or both, permanently or temporarily, whose compensation shall be fixed by the said weighmaster, subject to the approval of the comptroller of the state; and the annual salary His salary. of the clerk, whom the said weighmaster is now authorized to appoint, shall, from and after the first day of May next, be at the rate of one thousand dollars per annum, and the salary of the assistant weighmaster, whom the said weighmaster, is now authorized to appoint, shall, from and after the said last mentioned date, be at the rate of seven hundred and fifty dollars per annum.

470. He shall, from and after the first day of May Salary of weigh next, receive an annual salary of two thousand dol- master, &c. lars per annum; and all the salaries shall be payable monthly out of any moneys received by the weighmaster for the use of the state.

474.
