477. All assaults, riots, or other criminal acts Jurisdiction of which may be done or committed on the premises extended over aforesaid, shall be cognizable by the criminal court for Baltimore city, in the same manuer as if the same had been done or committed within the limits of said city.

MANURES.

1862, c. 19 repeals sections 486, 487, 488, 490, 491, 492, and 493 of this article, relating to the Inspection and Measurement of Manure. In force from January 7, 1862.

OYSTERS.

1864, c. 368 amends and re-enacts section 494 as follows:

494. All oysters carried to the city of Baltimore 1864, c. 368. How oysters for sale, shall be sold by the sealed half bushel, or shall be sold sealed bushel and half measure, and each and every person offending against the provisions of this section shall be subject to a fine of fifty dollars for each Penalty. and every offence, to be recovered before a justice of the peace of the city of Baltimore, by action of debt in the name of the state of Maryland, one-half to the informer, and the other half to the use of the state.

TOBACCO.

1864, c. 346 repeals sections from section 494 to section 552 and enacts the following in lieu thereof:

495. The governor, by and with the advice of the ¹⁸⁶⁴, c. 346, s. 1. senate, shall appoint as soon as possible after the of five inspecpassage of this act, and before the first Monday of February, at each regular session of the general assembly thereafter, five tobacco inspectors, one for each state tobacco warehouse in the city of Baltimore, whose terms of office shall respectively continue until their successors shall qualify; provided,
