water-pipe, gate-house, or other work constructed or used for supplying the city of Baltimore with water, or so near as to pollute the water therein, or who shall throw or cause to be thrown, any impure, fœtid or noxious animal or vegetable matter in said Swan lake, or in any dam, reservoir, line of conduit, water pipe, gate-house, or so near as to pollute the water in any of the works used in supplying the city of Baltimore with water, the person or persons so Penalty. offending, shall forfeit and pay a sum not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars for each offence.

941. If any person shall erect or cause to be Ibid s. 2.

Erecting privy, erected, any privy, hog pen, or other thing, over acc, over lake, or so near Swan lake, or any dam of the said works, as to pollute the water therein, the person or persons so offending shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding fifty dollars and the further sum of ten dollars Penalty. for each and every day the same shall remain, after due notice to remove the same shall have been given.

942. If any person shall injure or cause to be in- Ibid s. 3. jured, defaced or destroyed, any dam, reservoir, line ac. of conduit, water-pipe, gate-house, stop cock, or other thing, used for supplying the city of Baltimore with water, the person so offending shall forfeit and pay a sum not less than five, nor more than fifty Penalty. dollars for each offence.

943. All fines and forfeitures imposed by this act, Ibid 8 4 shall be recoverable by warrant, before any justice features, how of the peace, in and for the city of Baltimore, or in recoverable. and for Baltimore county, according to the respective jurisdiction under which any of the offences herein set forth may be committed; one-half to the informer, and the other half to the mayor and city council of Baltimore.
