58. The said president and commissioners shall have power to levy and collect taxes in said town upon the real and personal property thereof, not exceeding in any one year, thirty-three cents in the one hundred dollars on the assessable property in said town; they shall assess the property in said town annually, between the third Monday of April and the third Monday of May, by two assessors, to be by them appointed, who shall, before they proceed to assess said property, make an oath before some justice of the peace, that he will assess and value all the real and personal property within the town of Denton, without favor, affection, partiality or prejudice, to the best of his skill and judgment; but should any person feel aggrieved at the valuation and assessment of his or her property by said assessor, he or she may appeal from such valuation to the president and commissioners at any time within three weeks after the return of assessment, and the president and commissioners may make any alteration therein they may deem just.

59. The president and commissioners shall annually appoint a treasurer of the corporation, who shall keep accounts of the receipts and disbursements of the funds of the corporation in a well bound book, to be provided by the commissioners, and shall render annually to the president and commissioners an account thereof; but before the treasurer shall enter upon the duties of his office, he shall give bond to the state of Maryland, with security approved by the county commissioners of Caroline county, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned that he will well and faithfully account for all moneys paid over to him by the bailiff of said town, or any other person for the use of said town, and shall also well and truly pay over to the commissioners, or their order, all sums of money so received by him; and the said bond shall be recorded in the office of the
