

the bridge cross Choptank river at Dover Ferry, with their vehicles, carriages, wagons, carts, horses, mules, oxen, cattle, sheep, hogs, and all other property free from all toll or exaction of any kind.

66. The county commissioners of Caroline county are hereby required to levy and pay annually the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to whatever person or persons who may have charge of said bridge for the purpose of keeping said bridge and causeway leading to said bridge in repair, and to compensate the person who may attend the draw of said bridge.

JUSTICES OF THE PEACE.

1864, c. 317 adds the following :

140. When any justice of the peace shall resign, or be removed from office, he shall deliver his docket together with all notes, bonds, accounts, and papers, in his possession appertaining to judgments, or suits entered thereon, to his successor in office, within
