

27. No land within said corporation not fronting on any street or road shall be subject to taxation, but all front lots in said town fronting on any street shall be subject to assessment and taxation.

28. This act of incorporation shall in no wise exempt the county commissioners from keeping the county roads within said corporation in good repair, the same as though there was no corporation, unless the citizens within the corporation be exempt from county taxes, otherwise the corporate authorities shall not be bound to keep the county roads in repair within the limits of the corporation.

29. The burgess and commissioners may appoint a bailiff who shall preserve the peace and good order of the town, and for that purpose he shall have all the powers of a constable of the counties.

### ROADS.

1862, c. 216 adds the following sections to this article:

31. The county commissioners of Carroll county are authorized in their discretion to re-survey and mark and bound the public roads in said county, when and where they may deem such re-survey necessary and expedient.

32. Whenever the said commissioners shall deem it expedient that any of the public roads in said county shall be re-surveyed, they shall appoint three persons, not interested, nor holding lands through which said road may pass, and the persons so appointed, or a majority of them after giving thirty days' public notice thereof, shall meet on the premises, and re-survey and mark and bound such public road, according to the best evidence they can obtain of the location thereof, either by examination of witnesses, or by reference to former surveys, or by per-
