CECILTON.

1864, c. 353 enacts as follows :

SEC. 32. The citizens of Cecilton are a body politic 1864, c. 353, s 1.
Incorporated. by the name of the president and commissioners of the town of Cecilton, and as such shall have succession, and by their corporate name may sue and be sued, may grant, receive and do all other acts as natural persons, and may purchase and hold real, personal and mixed property, or dispose of the same for the benefit of said town.

sioners elected. twenty-one years, who shall have *bona fide* resided in said town for the space of six months, and twelve months in this state, next preceding the election, shall on the first Monday of May, annually, at such place as shall be designated by the president and commissioners of said town, elect five judicious and discreet persons, who shall have resided in said town twelve months next preceding the election, commissioners of said town.

34. If any of the commissioners, during the year Ibid s. 3.
Vacancies, how
filled. for which he was elected, shall die, resign, or remove from said town, or be otherwise disqualified, the remaining commissioners shall fill such vacancy until the next general election.

35. The said commissioners shall meet at such Ibid s 4.

appointed. times as they shall deem expedient, and may appoint a clerk to register their proceedings, and they shall at the first meeting after an election, choose from their own body a president, who shall preside at all meetings of the commissioners, vote on all
