CECILTON.

1864, c. 353 enacts as follows:

SEC. 32. The citizens of Cecilton are a body politic 1864, c. 353, 8, 1. by the name of the president and commissioners of Incorporated. the town of Cecilton, and as such shall have succession, and by their corporate name may sue and be sued, may grant, receive and do all other acts as natural persons, and may purchase and hold real, personal and mixed property, or dispose of the same for the benefit of said town.
