Power to pass  
by-laws, &c.

222. The said commissioners may pass all by-laws and ordinances necessary to give effect and operation to all the powers vested in the said corporation, and to impose fines, penalties and forfeitures for the breach thereof; but no ordinance of said commissioners shall impose a fine, penalty or forfeiture, for any one offence, of more than ten dollars.

Taxes.

223. They shall have power to levy and collect taxes in said town, not exceeding in any one year thirty cents in the hundred dollars, on the assessable property in said town.

Assessment

224. They shall once in three years or oftener if they think proper, appoint an assessor who shall under oath value and assess the property in said town, in the same manner and with like authority as county assessors, proceed to assess in the county.

Appeal from  
Assessment.

225. If any owner of property assessed in said town shall feel aggrieved by the assessment made by said assessor, he may appeal to the said president and commissioners, who may make such deductions therein, as to them may seem just and reasonable.

Bailiff.

226. The said commissioners or a majority of them, may annually appoint an active and discreet person to be bailiff, constable and collector within the limits of said town, who, before he shall proceed to the execution of his office, shall take an oath before a justice of the peace for said county, that he will faithfully and impartially perform the duties required of him as bailiff and collector within the limits of said town without favor, affection or partiality according to the best of his skill and judgment, and shall also give bond in the same manner and in the same penalties as the several constables of said county.
