Meetings of
commissioners

79. The commissioners aforesaid or a majority of them, may meet together from time to time as often as occasion may require, upon the business of said town, and not less than once in six months, and if during the time for which they may be elected, any of the commissioners should die, resign, remove from the said town, or be otherwise disqualified, an election to fill vacancy on ten days' notice thereof being given by the commissioners, shall be held, at which all persons qualified as is specified in the second section of this act, shall be entitled to vote.

Clerk, his
duties.

80. Said commissioners or a majority of them, shall have power to appoint a clerk and assign his duties, and allow him such compensation for his services as they may think proper, and that all ordinances passed by said commissioners or a majority of them, shall by their clerk be entered in a book to be kept by him for the purpose, and shall be open at all times for the inspection of any person interested.

Fines and forfeitures, how recoverable.

81. All fines and forfeitures under the ordinances of the said corporation, shall be recoverable as small debts are recoverable, out of court, before any justice of the peace.

82. The limits of said town shall be defined as beginning at a bridge at the head of Church Creek river on Loom Town road, thence running and binding the aforesaid river to Capt. Richard Linthicum's wharf; thence from said wharf, running by a straight line to the mouth of William T. Richardson's lane, on the road leading from Church Creek to Cambridge, thence from the mouth of said lane by a straight line to a barn belonging to Capt. Levin S. Fooks, on the road leading from Church Creek to
