CHAPTER II.

How Officers are Designated and Removed.

COUNTY BOARDS.

SEC. 1. The board of county school commissioners County boards, how composed and elected.
shall be composed of one commissioner for each election district, to be elected by the people thereof at each general election for members of the general assembly; to serve for two years from the first day of January next succeeding said election, and until their successors shall qualify and for the time intervening from the passage of this article until the first of January next succeeding the next general election, said school commissioners shall be appointed by the county commissioners of the respective counties.

2. The two school district trustees shall be elected Trustees.
by the legal voters of the school house district, at such time and in such manner as hereinafter set forth.

CHAPTER III.

County School Commissioners.

SEC. 1. The schools under the charge of the boards How schools designated.
of county school commissioners for each county, shall respectively be designated and constitute school districts No. 1, No. 2, &c., of the respective election districts of such county. The county board shall hold Sessions of county board.
four sessions a year; each session shall continue not longer than two days, and each commtssioner shall receive three dollars per day for each day of his attendance, and shall be paid by the school commissioners out of the school fund.
