association, to describe the said joint stock company or association by the name or title by which it is commonly known, or by or under which its business is transacted.

216. All corporations heretofore formed under the How far this article appligeneral laws of this state, relating to corporations, or cable to all under any special law, are hereby declared to be entitled to the benefit of and to be subject to all the regulations in this article contained for the government of the corporation herein referred to, so far as the same be applicable to said several corporations heretofore formed as aforesaid; and shall also have the benefit and be subject to the processes, remedies or proceedings, by this article authorized to be taken by or against the corporations herein referred to, so far as the same be applicable to the several corporations heretofore formed as aforesaid.

## CO-OPERATIVE STORES, &c.

217. No railroad or mining company, formed or stores conorganized under any of the provisions of this state, or railroad or which have organized under any existing laws, charter panies. or act of the general assembly of this state, shall own, conduct or carry on any store, or have any interest in any store, or receive any portion of the profits thereof; nothing herein contained, however, shall prevent the employees of any corporation from forming co-opera- Co-operative tive stores.

218. Any railroad company incorporated under the Steamships or laws of this state, may own and operate any line of connected with steamships or steamboats, or may subscribe to or hold nes. the stock of any company owning and operating such steamships or steamboats, where such steamships and steamboats can be used wholly or in part in connection with the business of said railroad company.

219. Every corporation incorporated under the laws Preferred of this state, which has the power to issue bonds as stock evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the same by
