

When and by whom certificate of publication to be furnished.

any debt or obligation in the construction of any railway, canal or other work of internal improvement or to give or loan its credit to or in aid of any association or corporation, shall be published; it shall be the duty of such association or corporation or of those individuals to be benefitted by said act of the general assembly, to furnish certificates under oath of such publication to the governor of the state and the president of the senate and speaker of the house of delegates of the general assembly next succeeding the passage of said act. And the cost of such publication shall be defrayed as is now required to be done in the publication of local laws.
