

execute, or have executed, either real or personal property for the payment of any county taxes then remaining due and unpaid, it being the intent and meaning of this act to require all persons, body politic or corporate, owing county taxes, to pay the same to the said treasurer, at his office, in the town of Upper Marlborough, or at the place designated by him in the different districts for receiving county taxes. The county commissioners of Prince George's county shall, upon the first Tuesday in April, or within fifteen days thereafter, in each and every year, appoint a collector of state taxes, who shall hold office for one year, and may be re-appointed, and shall give bond to the state of Maryland in the double sum of state taxes placed in his hands for collection, which bond shall be approved by the county commissioners, and be given within twenty days from the date of appointment, and, upon failure to do so, the county commissioners shall appoint a successor, and said collector shall be allowed a commission of six per cent. upon the amount placed in his hands for collection, if accounted for according to law; and it shall be the duty of the county commissioners to levy for said commission in the general levy of state and county taxes.
