AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL ASSOCIATION.

1870, c. 151, amending the charter of the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington county, by section 9, enacts:

That no booths or stalls shall be erected or opened at which spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold or exposed for sale within one-quarter of a mile from the grounds of said association, during the time that any fair or other exhibition is being held on the grounds of said association, unless permission to erect and open such booths or stalls shall have been first had and obtained from said association; provided, that this section shall not be construed to apply to any regular places of business.
